WEBSITE MOBILE APP

The parish web provider is currently offering a free 50 day trial of their Mobile App. This can be downloaded from the Google App store by searching for the School Jotter App (green pencil symbol as shown) and entering the name St Bede's, Rotherham or postcode S60 1HF. The trial app is a simple, standard version giving access to *some* of the website content, such as the calendar and galleries and, when a new notice or newsletter is added, you will be notified immediately. It is possible to have a bespoke version of the app tailored to St Bede's, however the cost of this to the parish is quite substantial. If you are interested please download the app so that the level of uptake may be monitored and a decision made as to whether the parish should buy into this service after the free trial period is over.
