### **Parish Council News**

When the Parish Survey was completed at the end of 2016 one of the key issues highlighted was a need for better communication within the Parish. Since then there has been a restructuring of the Parish Council and many efforts made to improve communication. A calendar has been added to the website along with new Parish Council pages which are regularly updated (including links to the minutes of all committee meetings). Ahead of the weekend the bulletin is also emailed to many parishioners on Friday. (Request slips are available at the back of church if you would like to receive the bulletin this way).

However, the most recent Finance & Maintenance meeting also recognised the need for more transparency with regard to the Parish finances. Parishioners of St Bede's & Forty Martyrs' are unfailingly generous in their support of the Church and it is only right that everyone should be aware of how funds are being used. For this reason a summary of the Parish finances for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017 is being handed out this weekend (also available on the website) and it is proposed that updates on the current year will be made available during the coming months.

**St Bede's School play area development:** The school have managed to secure funding to resurface the dri- play area at the front of school, which will enhance playtimes and sports provision for the pupils but they need to raise **£7,000** towards the cost of this.
